Registration Agreement

- 1) Full payment (or any remaining tuition balances) are due prior to or at the beginning of the first day's camp session.
- 2) Children must be dropped off at the scheduled beginning time of the camp and picked up at the scheduled end of the day or week.
- 3) Should a camper develop any disciplinary issues or cause harm, or exhibit propensities to cause harm to themselves, or to another camper, or to a Blue Point Stables staff member, or to any of the animals at the stables and on the farm; or should the camper engage in willful destruction of property and equipment, or should the camper arrive with any prohibited substances or weapons, the camper may be expelled, on the first occurrence, from the remainder of the camp session without a refund.
- 4) Blue Point Stables is NOT responsible for any missing personal items. We recommend that all personal items be clearly marked and labeled.
- 5) Camp may be cancelled and either a full refund will be returned or another camp selected (at the option of the parent), if the registration minimum numbers for that camp are not met.
- 6) Parents, Family Members or Guardians are welcomed to remain and observe and take pictures should they so desire.
- 7) Camper's cell phone texting and calls are restricted to those times when there is no engagement with the horses or class instruction activities.
- 8) The Camper's medical information form & release waiver form must be filled out as complete as possible and signed. These will be kept on file at Blue Point Stables.

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Camp Information

1) HELMETS:

- a. ASTM F1163-04a approved riding helmets are REQUIRED by Blue Point Stables and our Insurance Carrier, for all riders that have not yet reached their eighteenth birthday.
- b. ASTM F1163-04a approved Riding lesson helmets are provided by Blue Point Stables for all riders that do not possess their own.
- c. We recommend that parents consider purchasing and providing the camper with their own personal ASTM F1163-04a approved helmet.
- d. ASTM F1163-04a approved helmets can be purchased at Blue Point Stables at competitive prices.

2) ATTIRE:

- a. Parents should consider sending their camper with a back pack that contains a change of clothing, should that become necessary.
- b. Campers are welcomed to wear “*riding style specific*” attire, at their option.
- c. Blue Point Stables recommends that campers should simply wear clothing that is comfortable, Season specific and that will be allowed to become soiled and dirty.
- d. Long pants are REQUIRED when riding however, a change to modest shorts for the warm and hot weather months is suggested.
- e. Closed-toe shoes with a pronounced heel are a minimum mandatory when riding and boots would be best.
- f. Parents should consider the ambient conditions for the time of the year, when selecting the camper’s attire.
- g. Parents should consider “layering up,” including sweaters or hoodies and coats, gloves, scarves and additional appropriate head gear (when helmets are not being worn) for the colder weather camps.
- h. During those times of the year when Blue Point Stables has the swimming pool up and running, campers should bring their swimming suits to change into, along with a beach towel and flip-flops or shoes that parents won’t mind becoming wet.
- i. Additionally, during those times of the year that the weather becomes much warmer, parents might consider sending a change of clothing including shorts etc. for those times after equine related activities have concluded for the day.

3) MEALS (DAY & OVERNIGHT CAMPS):

- a. Cold storage is available for items needing refrigeration. A microwave oven is available for items needing to be heated.
- b. Blue Point Stables will provide tap water for drinking to all campers that do not bring additional drinks.
- c. Day campers must bring their own lunches, packed in either lunch packs or sacks, each day. Parents should consider their children’s normal eating habits when engaged in a rigorous day of activities. Snacks and extra drinks are recommended.
- d. Overnight camper’s meals are provided by Blue Point Stables. Parents should notify Blue Point Stables with any specific dietary requirements that your camper may have.

4) ACCESSORIES FOR DAY CAMPS:

- a. Warm Weather Camp Considerations:
Toothbrush & toothpaste, Personal Bug Spray, Sunscreen and, or U.V. protection
- b. Cooler to Cold Weather Camp Considerations:
Toothbrush & toothpaste, Lip-Balm or a Chap-Stick type of protection
- c. ALL personal items should be clearly marked and identified. Blue Point Stables is not responsible for any missing personal items.

5) NOTIFICATIONS TO BLUE POINT STABLES:

- a. Please call and notify Blue Point Stables if your camper will be running late and, or absent for a day of the camp.
- b. Parents, family members and family guests are invited and welcomed to attend the camper-guided tour of Blue Point Stables at the conclusion of the last day of camp. (All visitors arriving on premises must sign a waiver release to be kept on file by Blue Point Stables.)
- c. Some Blue Point Stables camps may offer a Camp T-Shirt. When offered, these are available for an additional price. Please notify Blue Point Stables with your camper’s sizes should you elect to purchase a Camp T-Shirt.

6) CAMP CANCELLATIONS:

- a. The Camp that your camper has enrolled in may be cancelled if the number of minimum registrants does not meet a minimum level.
 - i. Full refunds will be offered in the event of a Camp cancellation declared by Blue Point Stables.
 - ii. Campers will also have the option to select another camp and either receive a refund or pay any additional for the alternate camp, which ever applies.

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7) **MEDICAL FORMS:**

- a. Parents must complete a Blue Point Stables Camp Medical Form for each of their camper attending.
 - i. Completed Medical Forms are required for all campers and must be completed for each camp that the camper attends.
 - ii. These are kept on file for important medical information purposes.
 - iii. Blue Point Stables' client's privacy regarding their personal information is paramount to us. Blue Point Stables does not share this information with any persons or entities unnecessarily. The information provided on the Medical Form is only shared with emergency medical personnel and agencies attending to the Camper; and even then, only in the event of a medical necessity.

8) **DISCIPLINARY CONCERNS AND ISSUES:**

- a. Campers must maintain a positive and friendly disposition for the sake of their own personal enjoyment, as well as all of the other campers and camp associates.
- b. Campers are expected to participate in all activities with all of the other campers, in most cases. Blue Point Stables will not push any activities onto any unwilling campers. Gentle, persuasive attempts will be made to encourage any unwilling campers to participate. Ongoing and continuing circumstances will result in the parents being contacted in an attempt to discover the camper's concerns and motives. Lack of the camper's interest will result in the camper's termination of the camp without refund.
- c. Derogatory remarks and, or negative aggressive actions are not permitted at or during any Blue Point Stables functions, including camps.
- d. Campers that develop disciplinary issues or cause harm to another camper or a Blue Point Stables staff member or whom engage in willful destruction of property and, or equipment; run the risk of being expelled from the remainder of the camp session without a refund.

Additional Camp Information

a. **SKIN CARE:**

During warm or hot weather months we recommend a hat with a brim, sun screen and bug spray. These are suggested to be used on a daily basis as most of our camp activities take place outdoors.

b. **INCENTIVE REWARD:**

Campers can receive a day of camp FREE by referring a Blue Point Stables camp to a new client or customer. Conditions apply. Obtain more information by going to our web site and reviewing our referral program.

c. **LAST DAY OF CAMP (Buckaroo & Horselovers Only):**

At the end of each of our week long (5 Day) camps, the campers will put on a riding demonstration, exhibiting their skills at the end of the last day. Parents, grandparents, siblings, friends and neighbors are all invited to attend. The campers will give a private guided tour to their loved ones and explain what all they have been doing and have accomplished. Weather permitting, the campers will then present a show demonstration in our arena, for the viewing pleasure of their loved ones. Cameras are strongly recommended!
