WHAT TO BRING TO THE 2019 CAMP

Important Notice: *Blue Point Stables is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.*
VERY Important Notice: Please **clearly mark all of your camper's belongings** with their name.

CLOTHING

- Long pants for riding, generally jeans or riding breeches work well (required)
- Boots (or shoes) with a smooth sole and a 1" or greater heel designed to accommodate spurs if needed (required)
- Sneakers for comfort during leisure time (recommended)
- Hat or ball cap or head gear cover with a bill during bright light days (recommended)
- Bandanna/scarf (optional)
- Rain Gear &/or collapsible umbrella (recommended)
- Light jacket or vest for cool nights (recommended)
- Socks & underwear for daily change (PLUS SPARES) (recommended)
- Weather specific Tops, ie. T-shirts, Polo Type shirts, tank tops, other short sleeve shirts; enough to allow for a week's worth of regular change of clothes (required)
- Shorts (when not riding); enough to allow for a week's worth of regular change of clothes (required)
- Pajamas or sleep-wear (recommended)
- Light-duty bath / night robe (recommended)
- Bathing Suit (required if swimming)
- Swim shirt (optional if swimming)
- Goggles for swimming (optional if swimming)
- Swimming cap (optional if swimming)

NON-CLOTHING ITEMS

- Duffle Bag or Suitcase and Back Pack to contain camper's change of clothes and camper's other personal items (recommended)
- Small backpack for day rides (recommended)
- Sleeping bag or Bedrolls + Pillow (required)
- EXTRA BLANKET (HIGHLY recommended)
- Padding for bedroll or bag (recommended)
- A bath towel, wash cloth (required)
- Reusable personal water bottle or canteen (recommended)
- Extra drinks (optional, BPS provides water & limited soft drinks)
- Extra snacks (optional, BPS provides limited snacks)
- Wash cloth and towel (required)
- Journal to record the day's events (optional)
- Pen, paper, preaddressed envelopes & stamps (to mail letters home) (optional)
- Laundry bag (recommended)
- Disposable camera (recommended)
- Flashlight & spare batteries (recommended)
- Watch (optional)

NON-CLOTHING ITEMS CONTINUED

- Sunglasses (recommended)
- Entertainment, like books, hacky sacks, puzzles, cards, games (for leisure times) (optional)
- Cell Phones and Tablets (optional for use only when classes are not occurring)

Personal Hygiene & Related ITEMS

- Small pouch or bag to contain personal hygiene items (recommended)
- Toothbrush, toothbrush container & toothpaste (required)
- Mouthwash (optional)
- Lip balm (recommended)
- Soap + soap container & shampoo (required)
- Hair rinse (optional)
- Flip-flops for showers (recommended)
- Personal deodorant (recommended for age appropriate)
- Hair brush, comb & hair bow ties (recommended)
- Feminine hygiene supplies (for those applicable) (recommended)
- Nail Clippers (optional)
- Sunscreen with high SPF rating (recommended)
- Sunburn ointment, spray or gel (recommended)
- Outdoors personal & clothing bug repellent spray (highly recommended)
- Small pack of tissues (optional)
- A few band-aids & small tube of antiseptic cream such as Neosporin (optional)

Equine Equipment, Gear & Tack

- ASTM approved helmet** (optional – see below)
- Work gloves for stall activities (optional)
- Riding gloves for when riding (optional)
- Personal Crop (optional – BPS has crops)
- Your Horse (optional – Requires Prior Approval)
- Your Saddle, Bridle & other Tack (optional)
- Personal "ball" spurs (optional)
- Other Items (optional – Call BPS for Approval)

What NOT To Bring To Camp

- Please **DO NOT bring** guns, knives, bow & arrows or any type of weapon/s
- Please **DO NOT bring** any type of illegal items, articles or substances. *All illegal items, articles or substances will be confiscated and turned over to the appropriate authorities.*

** All campers **MUST** wear riding helmets that are SEI certified to meet or exceed ASTM F1163-04A standards. BPS provides student helmets for all campers whom do not bring their own.

- However, if you would prefer your camper have their own helmet, helmets can be purchased from BPS.
